# Iowa Junior Naturalist Requirements:

#### Age:

Participants should be between the ages of 6-12 years old.

#### Public Programs:

\* Attend three public programs. Examples include wildflower hike, night hike, fishing contest, campground program, hunter safety, etc..

#### Independent Activities:

\* Complete two independent activities such as reading a nature book, fishing, hunting, camping, bike riding along a nature trail, hiking, etc...

#### Awards:

collect them all.

Upon completion of the above requirements, participants will receive a certificate of achievement and a colorful embroidered Iowa Junior Naturalist patch.
